EWA has always been an exhibition, held in the North West, showing quality original works of art, selected from amateur and professional artists.

It has a good sales record, making it one of the best selling wildlife exhibitions in the UK. It is held in an award winning garden centre, on a main road, with a huge footfall of visitors. All successful artists work will be on the EWA Online Gallery for 10 months.

EWA Exhibition Conditions

Read and observe the exhibition conditions

General conditions

- The subject is wildlife.
- Entered works must be originals and have been completed in the last 2 years.
- They should not have been shown at previous EWA exhibitions.
- Computer generated images are not accepted.
- Works printed by hand, linocuts, etchings etc, will be accepted.
- The artist must be the owner of the copyright on all works. Source material must be available on request.
- Work must be framed to gallery standard, with taut cord, which is not visible when hung, and sealed at the back.
- Box canvases must have clean painted edges.
- No clip frames.
- Minimum sale price - £200.
- 10% commission on all sales.
- All online sales will be sent to the artist and it is their responsibility to arrange delivery.
- Cancellation of the contract must be done as soon as possible. The artist and EWA will endeavour to sell the space.
- Payments must be made in full (non refundable) once your entry is accepted.

EWA reserves the right to remove any work that is not uploaded on the artists page, or does not meet the criteria listed above.

Uploading images

The jpeg file should not exceed 1Mb.

The image must be taken flat with no mount or frame showing.

The quality of the image is the responsibility of the artist.

Insurance

Whilst every effort will be made by EWA, you are advised to insure your work whilst in transit or at the exhibition, as no responsibility can be taken by the organisers/ transporters for loss or damage, however caused.

Publicity and promotion

Unless otherwise stated by the artist in writing, the organisers may use your images to promote the exhibition.

Copyright remains the property of the artist.

Artist Book

EWA will produce a booklet, which will include all the artists accepted into the exhibition. Details entered on your page will be used.

Payment

All monetary transactions are £ sterling.

Application Form : Part 1

Submit by 7pm on Friday 6th March

An independent panel of judges will be selecting artists in Part 1.

The judges decision is final.

To enable a quality and a varied show for the public, upload four good images that represent your work. They must have been recently completed, see General Conditions above, and if possible, intended for this exhibition.

Titles and medium should have no more than 20 characters including spaces.

Your full name, address, phone number, search words and CV must be entered.

Check that all boxes are entered and are correct.

You will be notified by Friday 27th March of the judges decision.

Application Form : Part 2

Completed by 6pm on Monday 20th July

You will be contacted by EWA if accepted, to make payment and secure your chosen option.

A personal Reference Number will be issued.

Your reference number, when entered on the EWA website Home Page will access your form, enabling you to upload all your images, print labels, invitations and fliers etc.

Print 2 sets of EWA official labels on WHITE CARD. One set for the back affixed on the right hand side and one set for display.

Most of the boards have two legs which come over the board and take up hanging space, as does your name banner, 16 x 4inch.

Do not overcrowd your display space, as overcrowding rarely helps sales.

All packaging to be removed from the exhibition space, as no storage is available.

Please read carefully the options below before selecting your choice.

Option A – £200


This option requires the artist to be present and to demonstrate and show the public their method of work.

12ft x 4ft horizontal hanging space.

One 4' covered table, for your sketch books and demo piece only.

Only works that easily fit the boards, plus 3 extra in reserve, to be uploaded on your page.

For 3D works a 6ft covered table will be supplied.




Option B - £100

This option gives the artist the opportunity to attend the show at any time and promote their work.

6ft x 4ft vertical hanging space. (No legs)

Only works that easily fit the board to be uploaded on your page.



Option C – £75


This option is available for artists to just deliver their work.

4ft x 4ft hanging space.

Only works that easily fit the board to be uploaded on your page.

EWA will hang, and manage your panel during the exhibition.

3D work will be displayed on a glass stand. 2' x 2' approx, with 3 glass shelves.



Option D - Online Gallery only - £40

Only 8 images to be uploaded on your page for the online gallery.

Indicate whether framed or unframed eg. Rabbit Uf or Rabbit F.

EWA will contact you regarding sales online.

Delivery and collection of work

Option A artists must have completed their setup by 4pm on Thursday 23rd July.

Option B & Option C artists must deliver their work on Thursday 23rd July by 12 noon.

Unsold work must be collected on Monday 27th July before 12 noon.

Pick up Service

Some of our artists can transport the work of others to and from the exhibition for a small fee, contact EWA for information.

If you wish to send and have your work returned by your Courier, contact EWA to arrange times.
